

Advanced Disk Utility and Installer

The Advanced Disk Utility lets you initialize, name, erase, and partition hard disks. You can create more partitions on large SCSI hard disks than was possible in the past. The Installer program allows you to customize your startup disks (including hard disks) for use with a variety of peripheral devices. You can also update startup disks for use with the latest system software, adding only the updates you need.


- Apple IIGs workstation users can access AppleShare file and print servers.

- Apple IIGs workstation users can start up from an AppleShare file server without having a 3.5-inch disk drive.
- AppleShare-aware applications stored on the file server can be used by Apple IIGs workstations.
- System Software Version 5.0 integrates networking capabilities previously available only in the AppleShare IIcs® Workstation Software.


