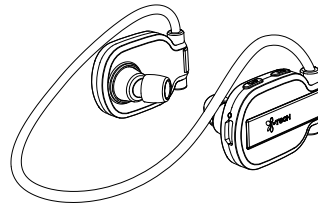

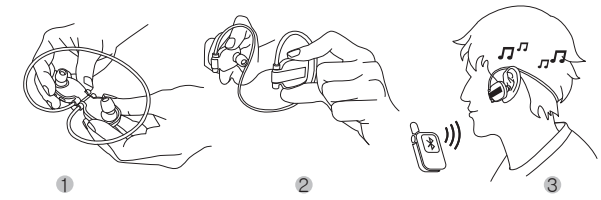

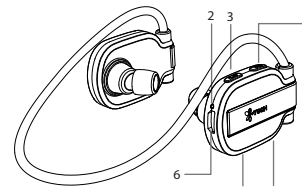

  - Play and Pause
  - Voice Dialing
4. Volume Up / Forward Button
5. Volume Down / Backward Button
6. Micro USB Charging Socket

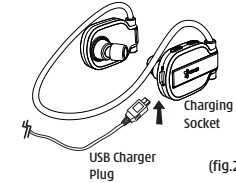

**Getting Started**

To use your MusicBAND 807 Bluetooth headset ("headset"), please follow the steps below:  
 1. Ensure your headset is fully charged.  
 2. Pair your charged headset with a Bluetooth-enabled mobile phone.

**Charging Your Headset**

The headset comes with a built-in rechargeable battery. Prior to using the headset for the first time, it is recommended to fully charge the battery. Insert the charger's plug into the headset's USB charging socket and plug the mains charger to an AC wall outlet or plug to the PC/notebook.

Use only the supplied charger / USB charging cable to charge the headset.

♦ Charging indication will be delayed for a few seconds if the headset has not been used for a long time or the battery is drained.

**Charging Your Headset**

- ♦ 3 hours are required to fully charge the headset.
- ♦ The headset remains in standby mode after being turned on.

\*Warning: Do not use the headset while it is connected to the charger.

**Pairing Your Headset with a Bluetooth Mobile Phone**

- 1) Ensure the headset is off.
- 2) To activate the pairing mode, press and hold the headset's MFB for 8 seconds without releasing your finger until its status indicator flashes blue and red alternately.
- 3) Activate your mobile phone's Bluetooth, search Bluetooth devices, select "MusicBAND 807" and enter the passcode "0000". When the pairing is completed, the headset's status indicator will flash blue rapidly 5 times and you can hear a long beep.

If the pairing cannot be completed within 3 minutes after the pairing mode has been activated, the headset's status indicator will flash blue rapidly 5 times and you can hear 3 short beeps. Then the headset turns off. Repeat steps 1 to 3 to pair both devices again.

**Using your headset**

Function	Button	Beep / Buzzer	Status indicator
POWER ON	Press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds	Short beep	Flash blue light 2 times
<b>When you turn on your headset for the first time, the headset proceeds into pairing mode, i.e. the status indicator flashes blue and red alternately, so that you can immediately pair it with your mobile phone.</b>			
POWER OFF	Press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds	Long beep	Flash red light twice
Incoming call		Ringtone through the earphone and buzzer ON	Blinking red
Answer / End a call	Press the MFB once		
Reject incoming call*	Press and hold the VOL for 2 seconds	Short beep

**Using your headset (cont'd)**

Function	Button	Beep / Buzzer	Status indicator
Adjust Volume	Press VOL UP or VOL DOWN	Short beep at max. and min. volume	
Voice Dialing*	In Any Mode, press and hold Play/Pause for 2 seconds	short beep	
<b>Say the voice tag as soon as you hear the short beep and you must have recorded the voice tag into your mobile phone.</b>			
Last no. Redial*	In Any mode, double click MFB		
Call Transfer (headset to mobile phone)*	Press and hold the VOL for 2 seconds		
Call Transfer (mobile phone to headset)*	Press and hold the VOL for 2 seconds

**Using your headset (cont'd)**

Function	Button	Beep / Buzzer	Status indicator
Call Waiting	Hold VOL UP for 2sec		
Play	Press Play/Pause once		
Pause	Press Play/Pause once		
Track forward	Hold VOL UP for 2sec		
Track backward	Hold VOL DOWN for 2sec

**Resetting Your Headset / Removing the Pairing History**

You may reset the headset to its default settings. Resetting will also remove the pairing history of your headset with the mobile phone.

1. During OFF mode, plug charging cable into the charging socket, then hold the VOL UP key until the headset sounds for 2 beeps.
2. Release the Volume key.
3. The status indicator will return charging mode and the headset is reset. You may also reset the headset to its default settings by hardware reset.

1. Plug charging cable into the charging socket
2. The headset is reset.
