# Terms of Warranty

Apple Computer Australia Pty. Ltd. ("Apple Computer Australia") warrants its product(s) against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 12 months from the date of original retail purchase. Repairs carried out to Apple equipment are warranted for 3 months from the date of the repair service.

This Warranty applies only to products that can be identified by the "Apple" trademark, tradename, or logo affixed to them. This Warranty does not apply to products not purchased from an Apple Computer Australia Authorised Distributor or Retail Dealer, or to products not manufactured by Apple.

This Warranty is only valid in Australia, and in countries as listed in the Authorised Apple Computer Australia Service Centre list provided with each product. Apple Products supplied by Apple Computer Australia through Authorised Distributors or Retail Dealers in those countries receive reciprocal Warranty amongst these countries.

Only Apple Computer Australia Authorised Service Centres are permitted to repair Apple Products under this Warranty.

During the Warranty period, Apple Computer Australia will authorise repair or, at its option, replacement of Apple Product(s) at no charge to the Owner should they prove to be defective, provided, however, that such Apple Product(s) are returned to an Apple Computer Australia Authorised Service Centre and that freight and insurance charges are pre-paid by the Owner.

The Owner must also enclose proof of the date of retail purchase of the product(s), a description of the problem, and contact name, address, and telephone number.

This Warranty does not apply if, after the Apple Product(s) have left the control of Apple Computer Australia, the product(s) have been damaged by accident, abuse, misuse or misapplication, neglect, improper voltage, or as a result of service or modification by other than an Apple Computer Australia Authorised Service Centre that affects the reliability and performance of the product(s), not arising from or caused by faulty manufacture or workmanship.

As a routine procedure all Apple Computers are subject to pre-delivery inspection and testing. If, during those procedures, parts are found to be defective, they may be replaced by factory re-worked exchange parts. These exchange parts may have been previously used; however, they carry the same Apple Warranty and after-sales service as new parts.

Subject to the following paragraph, the benefits conferred by this Warranty are in addition to all other rights and remedies which a "consumer," as defined in the Trade Practices Act, 1974, may have against Apple Computer Australia under the Trade Practices Act 1974 and all other non-excludable rights and remedies a consumer may have against Apple Computer Australia under similar State and Territory laws.

To the extent that liability under the Trade Practices Act, 1974, or such other State or Territory laws may be limited, the liability of Apple Computer Australia thereunder shall be and is hereby limited to replacement or repair of Apple Products at the sole option of Apple Computer Australia.

Except as expressly stated in this Warranty and as provided for by the legislation referred to in the preceding paragraph, all other warranties, conditions, and liability implied by Statute and by Rule of Law are hereby expressly excluded and negated, and Apple Computer Australia will not accept or have any other responsibility or liability whatsoever including liability for negligence or liability for incidental, consequential, indirect, or special damages, including without limitation, lost business profits.
