The new Macintosh Plus has a full megabyte of memory to let you take full advantage of high-performance Macintosh programs—and to let you run any Macintosh program faster.

All that memory means the Macintosh Plus can handle even the biggest job. Whether it's a complex financial analysis. Or a warehouse's inventory. Or a lengthy business report.

To give you storage to match all this new power, the Macintosh Plus has twice the internal disk capacity of the Macintosh. It uses 3½-inch double-sided disks that hold 800 kilobytes of data each. (That's about 400 pages of text—or several bulging file folders.) And it gets files and programs from the disk faster, too.

Which means you can store twice as much information, with

fewer disks to swap and manage. And you can do it quickly.

The Macintosh Plus not only stores more information than the Macintosh, but it also makes managing what you've stored easier than ever. There's a new, more efficient internal filing system, so no matter how many files (and files-within-files) you set up, you'll be able to get to the one document you want right away.

The Macintosh Plus also lets you attach up to seven devices—such as hard disks and tape backups—to a new high-speed connection on the back.

What's more, there's a new, bigger keyboard, with built-in cursor keys and a numeric keypad.

Now, if you choose to keep your Macintosh 128K or 512K the way it is, rest assured you'll still be able to get the software, service, and support you need from your authorized Apple dealer.

But as a Macintosh owner, you also have the option of choosing just the Macintosh Plus pluses you want.

The Macintosh Plus gives you all the advantages of a Macintosh. Plus more power, speed, capacity, and expandability.

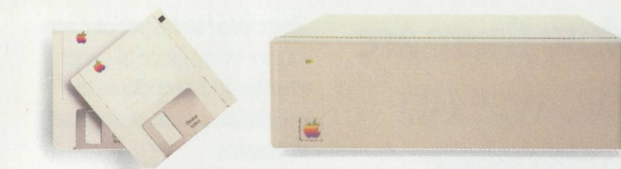
Three ways to add a big Plus to your life.

For starters, you can get all the powerful new file-management capabilities and disk storage capacity of the Macintosh Plus, just by getting the **Macintosh Plus Disk Drive Kit**.

The kit doubles the storage capacity of your Macintosh with an 800K built-in disk drive—the same as the one in the Macintosh Plus. Which means you can store more applications and documents on a single disk. And you can get to them faster than before. What's more, you can use all your 400K application and data disks in the new drive.

The kit also doubles the built-in memory (ROM) of your Macintosh. And makes your Macintosh just as fast and efficient as the Macintosh Plus in getting to your files and programs. It also gives you the ability to start up directly from a Macintosh Hard Disk 20, without using a 3½-inch disk first.

Have your dealer add the **Macintosh Plus Logic Board Kit**, too, and you'll be building up to the power and speed of a full megabyte of internal memory. Memory you can later expand—without a board exchange—to as much as 4 megabytes.



These 3½-inch double-sided disks store 800 kilobytes of data each, or about 400 typewritten pages.

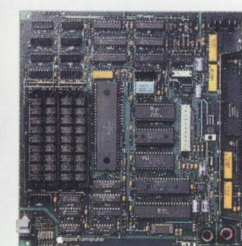
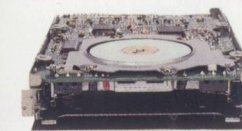
A Macintosh Hard Disk 20 stores 20 megabytes of application programs and data files in one convenient location—right under your Macintosh.

With more memory, your Macintosh can take on even bigger projects—larger documents, financial models, data bases, whatever. And it can get through them faster.

What's more, all that memory makes your Macintosh ideal for use with the **Switcher™**, a program that lets you move quickly between the applications you use frequently. You can load several large documents—say a budget, a data base, and a business plan—into the Switcher. And then change back and forth between the documents—and move information between them—as easily as you switch back and forth between papers on your desk.

The Logic Board Kit also includes the fast new connection we mentioned. It's called a parallel SCSI port, and it makes your Macintosh compatible with a wide variety of industry-standard peripherals, such as hard disks and tape backups. The SCSI port can also communicate with these devices faster than you can read this sentence.

The third plus adds the new, bigger **Macintosh Plus Keyboard**—with a numeric keypad and cursor keys—to your Macintosh.

The numeric keypad is separate from the other keys, which makes working with numbers much easier—a plus for many business applications, such as spreadsheet and accounting programs. And when you're using many Macintosh programs, you can control the cursor with cursor keys as well as with the mouse.
